

# **ROTHWELL GYMNASTICS**

## **GUIDELINES** **FOR PARENTS, GUARDIANS & VISITORS**

As part of the club's protection policies for children and vulnerable adults we kindly request that all non-members on club premises adhere to the following rules and procedures...

- Please do not enter the gymnastics hall unless you have a child in training or registered at the club. There are chairs for viewing if you wish to watch a class. If you remain to view, please do not act in a way which may distract the gymnasts or coaches whilst training. Please keep quiet.
- If your child is being collected by someone who does not normally pick them up, please make sure the coach in charge of the session is aware of this
- Ensure you arrive in time to help with equipment at the end of the session. In an emergency if you are unavoidably delayed, please contact a coach at the club. Failure to do this means that after 20 minutes children's services or the police will be contacted as per BG Guidelines.
- No photography or video recording equipment including photo and video imaging phones may be used during training sessions without permission.
- Please ensure that your child is aware of and abides by the members code of conduct (displayed on notice boards)
- Please avoid any behaviour that could be interpreted as intimidating, this includes threatening, bullying, trying to gain an unfair advantage and public disparagement of club members/coaches
- If you wish to raise and concern about any aspect of the club procedures or regarding a specific incident please contact a welfare officer Pam Stevenson, Bekki Goodison or Alison Goodspeed.
- If you wish to have information about your child's training please ask their coach directly.
